- <u>HeatCash:</u> immediate support during extreme heatwaves that threaten livelihoods.
- RainCash: assistance designed for those enduring the impacts of intense rainfall.
- <u>DroughtCash:</u> cash assistance for those impacted by extended periods of drought.

Each ClimaCash+ product leverages parametric triggers, such as the objective and data-driven indicators, that activate claims as soon as certain conditions are met. This ensures a swift and transparent process, providing timely financial assistance to help communities and businesses address immediate challenges and begin recovery more effectively.

At the core of this launch is a partnership between IBISA, the leading global climate Insurtech, and VisionFund, the financial empowerment and livelihood arm of World Vision.
